#### A1-1. Facilities Overview:

- Basic amenities include a bed, desk, wardrobe, air conditioning or heating.
- There are common areas (laundry room, kitchen, lounge) that must be used according to the rules.
- Electricity is 220V, so students coming from abroad should prepare a power adapter in advance.
- Bedding (pillow, blanket, bed sheets) is provided, but additional personal items may need to be prepared separately.
- Shower items (shampoo, towels, soap, etc.) are not provided, so students should prepare them individually.

### A1-2. Dormitory Rules:

- The curfew for the dormitory is 23:40, and opening hours are 05:00.
- Bringing alcoholic beverages and cooking in the dormitory is prohibited.
- Please dispose of only toilet paper in the toilet (do not flush wet wipes).
- Bedding distribution:

Bedding can be collected from the C-building security office, and male students return it to the C-building security office, while female students return it to the G-building security office.

\* When checking out, please return bedding in the original plastic bag provided.

#### A1-3. Facilities:

- Lounge: C-Building Room 211, G-Building 3rd, 5th, and 7th floors
- Laundry Room: C-Building Lobby floor, G-Building 9th floor

#### A1-4. Meal Information:

- 1. During weekdays, it is convenient to use the Hanma Hall cafeteria for lunch while attending classes.
- 2. The Hanma Hall cafeteria can be found on the 2nd floor of Hanma Hall in the 'Staff Cafeteria'.
  - \* Operating hours: 11:30 AM 2:00 PM
  - \* Closed on weekends.
  - \* Meal cost is 4,000~6,500 won.

Q2. Nearby Supermarkets and Purchasing Daily Necessities

#### A2

- There are large supermarket(Lotte Mart) and convenience stores near the dormitory where you can easily purchase daily necessities.
- Supermarkets sell a variety of goods such as groceries, household items, electronics, clothing, etc., so if you lack any items, you can buy them locally.
- Convenience stores (e.g., GS25, CU, 7-Eleven) are often open 24 hours, making it easy to purchase snacks, drinks, and essential items at any time.

### Q3. Payment Methods

#### **A3**

- Cash (Korean Won, KRW): Some small shops or traditional markets may prefer cash payments, so it's advisable to prepare a small amount of cash.
- Debit & Credit Cards: International cards with overseas payment functions like Visa, MasterCard, and UnionPay are generally accepted.
- Mobile Payments: In Korea, payment systems such as KakaoPay, Samsung Pay, and Naver Pay are common, but Alipay and WeChat Pay may not be accepted everywhere. Therefore, it's safer to prepare both a card and cash rather than relying solely on mobile payments.

Q4. Procedure for Visiting a Hospital in Korea if You Get Sick

#### Α4

- Mild Symptoms (such as a slight cold or headache):
- 1. You can buy medicine at a nearby pharmacy (available without a prescription).
  - 2. If symptoms worsen, visit an internal medicine clinic.
- Severe Symptoms (such as high fever or severe pain):
  - 1. Get medical treatment at the local public health center or hospital.
- 2. Be aware that if you don't have national health insurance, medical costs can be high, so check your insurance status.
- Emergency Situations (such as accidents or major injuries):
  - 1. Call 119 to request an ambulance.
  - 2. Go to the emergency room for quick treatment.
